1. Call to Order, Roll Call, Pledge and Acknowledge Guests

President Spehar called the Truth in Taxation Public Hearing meeting to order on June 1, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. President asked that the record show that there is a quorum and the only member absent is Jennifer White. He acknowledged guests.

2. Call to the Public

President Spehar made a call to the public in regard to any issue within the jurisdiction of the Gila Community College District Governing Board. President asked if there was anyone who wished to address the Board at this time. There was no response from the public.

3. 2017-2018 Gila Community College District Budget

A. Truth in Taxation Hearing on the Proposed 2017-2018 Budget

President Spehar stated that the background information is that the proposed 2017-2018 property tax levy increase will be presented in June for approval by roll call vote in accordance with the requirements of Arizona revised statutes. Notice has been published for Gila County residents. The proposed primary property tax increase of 2% will cause the taxes on a \$100,000 home to increase from \$91.78 to \$93.61, which will include the proposed tax increase. He stated that this was the time for discussion on the Truth in Taxation increase for the 2017-18 Budget. There were no comments to the Truth in Taxation Hearing on the proposed 2017-2018 Budget.

B. Public Hearing on the Proposed 2017-2018 Budget

President Spehar again stated that the proposed 2017-2018 Budget had been reviewed in detail twice and the Notice of Truth in Taxation Tax Increase according to Arizona law had been read. He asked if there were any public comments regarding the Notice. There was no response from the public to the Public Budget Hearing on the proposed 2017-2018 Budget. President stated since there was no response from the public regarding the proposed 2% increase in the primary property tax levy or the 2017-2018 Budget, he called for a motion to adjourn the Truth in Taxation public hearing.
