A. President Brocker indicated that pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(4), the Board may, upon a vote of a majority of the members, elect to go into Executive Session, which will not be open to the public, for discussion or consultation for legal advice with the attorney or attorneys of the public body contracts subject to negotiation.

Motion made by VP Moorhead, seconded by Secretary Cockrell to move into Executive Session at 2:10 p.m.

Motion made by President Brocker, seconded VP Moorhead that Gila County Provisional Community College District terminate the Eastern Arizona College Educational Services and Programs Intergovernmental Agreement and Eastern Arizona College Operating Agreement effective June 30th, 2024, and that President Brocker be authorized to work with Gila's legal counsel to notify EAC of the termination and work through the transition, seconded by VP Moorhead.
